CALL FOR APPLICATIONS - 10 SCHOLARSHIPS -

THE PROJECT

The Ecole des Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales, the CéSor (Centre d'études en sciences sociales du religieux) and the Istituto di Studi Bizantini e Post-Bizantini of Venice are funding the fourth edition of IIPS—International Itinerant Paleography School. The action (which is supported by the Collège de France, the Ecole Pratique des Hautes Etudes, the École nationale des chartes the universities of Bari, Florence, Padua, Rome, Salerno and Venice), will consist in a six-day training session:

Venice, Padua and Florence – 29 June to 5 July 2024

The focus of the initiative will be on ancient and medieval books, inscriptions and archival documents. This year, 10 fellows will participate in the research-intensive training programme, which includes seminars, lectures and visits to libraries, museums and research institutes. IIPS is a comparative and transdisciplinary study project centred on materials produced and circulated in the Mediterranean area from Antiquity to the Middle Ages. These include papyri, ostraca, tablets, parchments and inscriptions in Greek, Latin, Arabic and Coptic. The programme has a twofold objective. First, the seminars and visits, conducted by a team of leading scholars from Italy, France and Greece, will offer a unique opportunity for international scientific training. Second, young scholars will acquire comprehensive experience in working with manuscripts, from the study and publication of texts to aspects of conservation and public display. They will engage with academics, librarians, archivists, conservators and technicians, allowing them to discuss a broad range of issues from a diachronic and comparative perspective, based on a wide variety of skills, fields of expertise and cultural models.

TEACHING TEAM

The teaching team includes professors from the École des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales, the Collège de France, the École Pratique des Hautes Études (Paris), and the universities of Bari, Padua, Rome, Florence, Salerno and Venice.

SCHOLARSHIPS

IIPS invites applications for <u>10 fellowships</u>, which will be awarded to <u>master's and doctoral students</u>.

Each scholarship includes

- 1) accommodation in Venice (Istituto di Studi Bizantini e Post-Bizantini)
- 2) participation in seminars and lectures
- 3) travel by rail from Venice to Florence

Scholarship holders will therefore be responsible for the cost of travel to and from their home country; meals; access to 'free visits' (see programme); travel between Venice and Padua (a short distance); travel within Venice and Florence.

Fellows will be required

- a) to participate in all visits/seminars ('free visits' are optional)
- b) to participate in the fellows' workshop on the first day, with a brief presentation of their own research project (10 minutes, using Powerpoint)

Fellows are responsible for obtaining valid passports and any necessary visas.

Certificates of participation will be issued to fellows after they have submitted a written presentation, together with photographic documents, of one of the seminar visits (a signed authorization form will be required for publication of the presentation on the IIPS website).

Participation in IIPS is also open to <u>4 auditors</u>, selected from post-doctoral students and professionals (librarians, archivists, etc.) after submitting an 'auditor application' (see below). Auditors will be able to take part in all IIPS initiatives, but will receive no assistance (accommodation, group dinner, train tickets). No certificates of participation will be issued to auditors.



APPLICATION

Eligible candidates:

- a) students enrolled in a master's programme
- b) doctoral students

The following may apply as auditors:

- a) post-doctoral students
- b) librarians
- c) archivists
- d) professionals working in a sector related to IIPS activities

Candidates certify that they understand both English and French.

- 3) a curriculum vitae et studiorum indicating your fields of interest
- 4) a letter of recommendation from your supervisor this can be sent separately, to the same address, subject line « **Recommendation letter + name of candidate** » (not required for free auditors)
- 5) any other relevant documents
